

MB heads Negri honours list

SEREMBAN: Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Aminuddin Harun heads the list of 473 recipients of titles and awards in conjunction with the 76th birthday of the Yang Di-Pertuan Besar of Negeri Sembilan Tuanku Muhriz Tuanku Munawir today.

Aminuddin, who is also Port Dickson MP and Sikamat assemblyman, is the sole recipient of the Darjah Seri Utama Negeri Sembilan (SUNS) which carries the title Dato' Seri Utama.

Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Razarudin Husain will be conferred the Darjah Seri Setia Negeri Sembilan Yang Amat Cemerlang (SSNS) which carries the title Dato' Seri.

They will be bestowed the titles at the Istana Besar Seri Menanti in Kuala Pilah today.
